

# Pinecrest Cross Country Ski / Snowshoe Network



**MISSION:** To form a loosely organized volunteer group of Pinecrest winter snow users to develop a FREE recreational, transportation network of cross country ski trails and snowshoe paths off of the plowed roads but with connections across the plowed roads. This network of cross country ski trails and snowshoe paths will provide new recreational, social and community related events enhancing winter time recreation for cabin owners, resort guests and day users in the Pinecrest area.

## **VOLUNTEERS:**

Cabin owners and Pinecrest area users can help to build the XC ski/snow network by:

- (1) Help to shovel “cut throughs” at special defined points on the Pinecrest Cross Country Ski network map.
- (2) Develop trails with parallel sets of snow trails, one with cross country ski tracks and another for snowshoes, walkers and dogs.
- (3) Organize social and recreational events to get trail users to connect including tours, lessons, kids events, and night skis.
- (4) Distribute Pinecrest Cross Country ski network maps to your friends and fellow users
- (5) Encourage local merchants and businesses to rent, sell and service cross country skiing and snow shoe equipment for users to help promote the network.
- (6) Develop and mark cross country ski and snow shoe trail connections to Strawberry and other cross country areas like Crabtree, Gooseberry and Dodge Ridge
- (7) Introduce more users to cross country skiing and snow shoeing by inviting others to volunteer and use and develop the Pinecrest Cross Country Ski and Shoeshoe Network.

## **TRAIL ETIQUETTE:**

*When developing a trail after a fresh snow fall, always develop a two user trail that contains a cross country set of ski tracks and a parallel set for snowshoes and walkers and dogs. Please always use the appropriate trail for your use to maximum the use of the trail for others.*

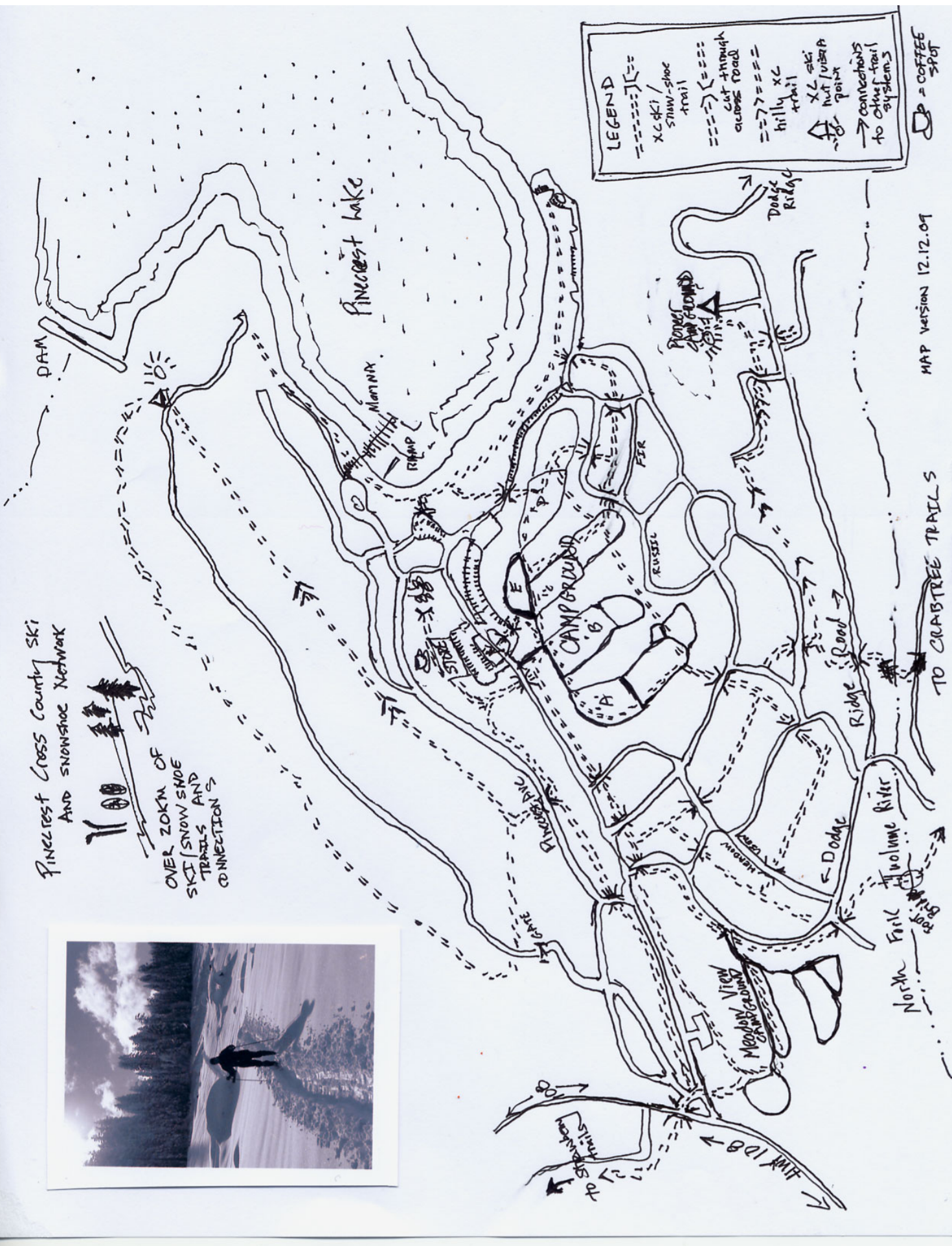
### Creating Cut throughs connections

To make cross country skiing or snowshoeing a fun and effective form of recreation and transportation in the Pinecrest area, special road level “cut through” connections must be made at special locations to allow XC skiers to cross plowed roads without having to climb up and down banks created by snow plowing the roads. Please help to create and maintain these connections when feasible.
